

# **Application for the Tom Joyner Foundation 2014 Full Ride Scholarship**

#### The Full Ride Scholarship

The Tom Joyner Foundation Full Ride Scholarship is this organization's most prestigious scholarship award. One scholarship will be awarded to a freshman entering a Historically Black College or University (HBCU) in the United States in the fall of 2014. The scholarship recognizes academic distinction as well as strong character and personal qualities.

The recipient of the Full Ride Scholarship will receive full tuition waivers and stipends to cover room and board (on campus only) and books. The scholarship recipient will have to maintain a required 3.0 GPA (on a 4.00 scale) and 15 credit hours per semester -the scholarship award will be renewed each semester up to ten (10) semesters.

### Eligibility

- 1. United States Citizen
- 2. Current high school seniors attending school in the United States (applicant must be anticipating completion of high school in the spring of 2014).
- 3. Minimum high school grade point average of 3.50 (on a 4.00 grade scale, excluding home school studies) and Minimum SAT score of 2100 (math, essay and verbal)/ or ACT score of 30.
- 4. Applicants must have applied and been accepted into an HBCU by July 1, 2014.
- 5. Applicants must have demonstrated leadership abilities through participation in community service, extracurricular, or other activities.

#### **Selection Criteria**

Students will be selected as finalists based on their academic accomplishments, intellectual and creative distinctions, extracurricular activities, letters of reference, and original essays. Finalists will be invited for a required interview with members of the Full Scholarship Selection Committee. Interviews will occur on or around April 5, 2014.

#### Forms to Submit

- I. Two copies of the applicant's official high school transcript. At least one copy must be certified by the registrar or other recognized official. If SAT or ACT scores are not included, the candidate must arrange to have such results forwarded by a responsible official to The Tom Joyner Foundation Full Ride Scholarship Committee postmarked no later than January 17, 2014.
- I. Two copies of a list of your <u>senior year</u> high school courses for 2013-2014.
- III.) Two letters of recommendation; one from a high school teacher and the other from a teacher, counselor, administrator, or person who can objectively assess your abilities and character. (no family members, please). Do not submit more than two letters. Please ask your references to address the following:
  - Reference's position or title
  - Indicate how long and in what capacity you have known the applicant? Describe the applicant's motivation and potential for academic success. Please be specific.
  - Describe the applicant's distinctive qualities or unique characteristics that you have personally observed that make the applicant particularly qualified to receive a Full Ride Scholarship.
- IV.) Essay (Type as separate copy and attach to application)
  - Please address in 350 words or less the most impressionable moment in your life and why. How did this experience influence your goals?
- V.) Completed application.
