DESCRIPTION

- The Tom Joyner Foundation has announced the TJF Fine Arts Scholarship Program. Four (4) deserving students from four (4) Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) will receive a \$500 scholarship from the Tom Joyner Foundation.
- A portion of the proceeds from the 2015 Tom Joyner Foundation Fantastic Voyage Art at Sea was designated for the program.
- Funds will be awarded for the 2016 spring semester.
- The program ends January 30, 2016.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE AND HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Open to all HBCU students attending a TJF supported institution majoring in art, fine arts (which includes music, theater, and dance), or art education.

- Students must be enrolled full time and be in good academic standing with their HBCU.
